Your Alberta Immigrant Nominee Program (AINP) Nomination gives you six (6) months to submit your Application for Permanent Residence as a Provincial Nominee to Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC). You are expected to submit your complete application to CIC before your Nomination expires. If your Nomination expires and you request an extension, the reasons why you need an extension will be reviewed by the AINP. **There is no guarantee that you will be issued an extension.**

To request a nomination extension from the AINP, complete this form, assemble any supporting documents required, and fax to the AINP at (780) 427-6560. The AINP will not accept incomplete forms or forms without supporting documents.
